LIFE MESSAGES FROM TODAY'S GOSPEL

1. The authenticity of our religion is guaranteed by the value of our love for real people. One could use the image of the flower that is rooted in the soil; it grows slowly by transforming the elements of the soil into its own living cells and eventually reaches up to the beauty of the sky with its own form, color and scent. The one sap enlivens the root, the stalk, the flower and produces the perfume.

2. Converts were drawn to the Christian faith by the way these Christians were leading their lives. The word of the good news diffused itself quietly through people admiring the way the Christians lived.

3. If we could plumb the depths of meaning in our own personal life histories, we might be able to forge more effective links with others. The gift of our humanity, savored and appreciated, can become both mirror and window to the mystery of God for ourselves.

4. For Jesus, what God wants from us - above all else - is love. There is no genuine love of God unless it finds expression in love of our neighbor. Love of neighbor, in turn, presupposes a healthy self-love, recognizing and appreciating ourselves as fundamentally good, because we are created in the image and likeness of God.

5. Loving our neighbor means we need to help, support, encourage, forgive, and pray for everyone without discrimination based on color, race, religion, gender, age, wealth, or social status. Forgiveness, too, is vital. We love others by refusing to hold a grudge for a wrong done to us. Even a rebuke can be given as an act of love, if it is done with the right heart.

6. We also express love through encouragement and by helping others to grow. We express *agâpe* love in meeting the needs of others by using the talents and blessings that God has given us - to comfort each other, to teach each other and to share the Gospel with each other, in good deeds and in words.

Loving God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength, (in response to His total love for us) means that we should place God's will ahead of ours, seek the Lord's will in all things, and make it paramount in our lives. We must keep His Commandments, and offer daily prayers of thanksgiving, praise and petition. We also need to read and meditate on His word in the Bible and accept His invitation to join Him in the Mass and other liturgical functions.

May the Lord, our loving God and Father, continue to love each and every one of us, bless us and take good care of us, as He has done all this while. Amen. In Christ, Father Macdonald Akuti
