

LIFE MESSAGES FROM THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

- 1) The baptism of Jesus reminds us of our identity. It reminds us of who we are and whose we are. By Baptism, we become sons and daughters of God, brothers and sisters of Jesus, members of his Church, heirs of Heaven, and temples of the Holy Spirit.
- 2) Jesus' baptism reminds us of the invitation to experience the presence of God within us, to acknowledge our own dignity as God's children, and to appreciate the Divine Presence in others by honoring them, loving them and serving them in all humility.
- 3) We are invited to live as the children of God in thought, word and action - To lead holy and transparent Christian lives and not to desecrate our bodies (the temples of the Holy Spirit and members of Jesus' Body), by impurity, injustice, intolerance, jealousy or hatred.
