MESSAGE FROM FATHER ANGELO

Are you who you say you are? The weekday readings this past week were focused on the hypocrisy of the scribes and pharisees. Jesus does not sugarcoat anything but tells it as it is. He challenges them to be authentic. In the parable from Luke 11:37-41, Jesus says “Oh you Pharisees! Although you cleanse the outside of the cup and the dish, inside you are filled with plunder and evil”. To this day, so many of us are sometimes too focused on the external and superficial; we act and sound like Catholics, but inside is a different story. As I prayed the divine office on the evening of Wednesday, I was especially inspired and challenged by the reading. Please include the words of John in your reflection for the week and I hope that it will speak to you as much as it did for me.

The way we can be sure of our knowledge of Christ is to keep his commandments. The man who claims, “I have known him,” without keeping his commandments, is a liar; in such a one there is no truth. But whoever keeps his word, truly has the love of God been made perfect in him. The way we can be sure we are in union with him is for the man who claims to abide in him to conduct himself just as he did. (1 John 2:3-6)
